

In order to enjoy your Drive-In experience, we have established necessary rules to address safety, conduct and operational procedures. We require everyone follow the rules of policy at all times. They are simple, easy to understand and follow. We look forward to your cooperation, and we reserve the right to require anyone to leave without refund should you **choose** not to follow these rules. Please review the rules and let's have a FUN Drive-In experience!

#### RULES AND PROCEDURES:

- Never drive over 3 MPH
- Keep your ticket stub at all times
- Do not leave the Drive-In, or you will need to pay to re-enter
- The use of laser pointers, cameras, or video recorders is not permitted
- Be considerate to others
- No Alcoholic beverages or glass bottles
- No Dogs allowed
- No BBQ or open flame cooking allowed
- No refunds due to bad weather.

#### OUTSIDE FOOD POLICY

- Please, no outside food or drink. The economics of the movie business(Drive-In and Walk-In) are as follows: a high percentage of the box office admission goes to the film companies to recoup the millions of dollars it takes to produce and market a movie these days. Theatres heavily rely on the sales from the concession stand to stay alive. Restaurants, bowling alleys, sport stadiums, and most other businesses that rely on concession sales to stay in business do not allow patrons to bring their own food and drink to the venue. We understand in rare cases there are special dietary restrictions and needs. Arrangements can be made in advance for these individuals. Thank you for your understanding and following our food policy which will allow us to keep the Drive-In open

#### PARKING RULES:

- 1 space per vehicle, must park facing with front or back of vehicle toward the screen... no sideways parking
- No saving spaces for other vehicles
- All trucks, vans, and SUVs should park level with, or behind concession stand
- Management reserves the right to assign parking rows to a vehicle because of special circumstances
- All hatch backs must be kept closed or tied down to the roof level of your vehicle

#### SAFETY RULES:

- Always drive at 3 MPH or SLOWER!
- After parking in a chosen space do not move your vehicle without making sure no one is sitting, standing or walking where they could be injured. The same applies when leaving for the evening...PEDESTRIANS ALWAYS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY. MANAGEMENT ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ACCIDENTS THAT OCCUR ON THE PREMISES
- No sitting on top of vehicles
- When outside of your vehicle wear your shoes
- No Running
- When sitting outside your vehicle on chairs, blankets, you must place them in front of your vehicle. DO NOT sit in front of other vehicles or in other parking spaces.
- Young children must be accompanied by an adult at ALL TIMES when outside your vehicle.

#### BASIC INFORMATION:

- You need an FM radio to hear the movies
- We do not keep jumper cables on the premises
- All cars must exit at the end of the evening. Those with dead batteries need to be pushed beyond the gate if the vehicle cannot be started by the end of closing.
- Do not leave unwanted items behind. We are not responsible for discarding old furnishings and unwanted tires
